**Rough Terrain Forklift (RTFL)
Operator Safety Training
OSHA 29 CFR 1910.178 (L) Class 7**

Applicability: The requirements applicable to RTFL's under this paragraph are identical to those set forth in 29 CFR 1910.178(l). Applies to persons engaged in the design, maintenance, and use of Vertical Mast Type, Truck/Trailer Mounted Type and Variable Reach Type Trucks (aka Rough Terrain Fork Lift), and detailed as Class 7 per OSHA 1910.178.

Prerequisites: None

Frequency/Duration: This training program requires 4 to 6 hours (Depending on participants skillset and experience) to complete, and Refresher training is required every 3 years.

Purpose and Overview:

Safety Training Plus, will conduct (OST) Operator safety training or (RST) Refresher safety training required by the OSHA (PIT) Powered Industrial Truck Standard (29 CFR 1910.178 [L]), to persons engaged in the operation and maintenance of Vertical Mast Type, Truck/Trailer Mounted Type or Variable Reach Type Trucks (aka Rough Terrain Fork Lift), and detailed as Class 7 trucks per OSHA 1910.178.

Operators will be trained in the safe operation of RTFL's and in the performance of tasks such as the following;

- Pre-Operation Inspection
- Function Testing
- Starting
- Handling Loads
- Truck Maneuvering
- Traveling
- Stopping
- plus applicable activities in which operators would encounter within their work place requirement regarding the operation of the RTFL.

NOTE: Industrial Forklifts Class #1 - #6 operator training is not included in this training program (per OSHA requirements) and are treated as separate training instruction courses.

Training Materials: Those attending this training program will receive a training manual and Photo ID wallet card; that will be awarded to the student upon successful completion of the training course.
