## Skid Steer Loader Operator Safety Training OSHA 29 CFR 1926.602 (d)

**Applicability**: The requirements applicable to construction work under this paragraph are identical to

those set forth at 29 CFR 1910.178(I). Applies to persons engaged in the design, maintenance, and use of skid-steer type powered industrial vehicles primarily

recognized as earth-moving equipment.

**Prerequisites:** None

Frequency/Duration: This training program requires 4 to 6 hours (Depending on participants skillset and

experience) to complete, and Refresher training is required every 3 years.

## **Purpose and Overview:**

Safety Training Plus, will conduct (OST) Operator safety training or (RST) Refresher safety training required by OSHA Materials Handling standard (29 CFR 1926.602[d]), to persons engaged in the operation and maintenance of skid steer type powered industrial vehicles primarily recognized as earth-moving equipment.

Operators will be trained in the safe operation of Skid Steer Loaders, including basic safety knowledge of tasks such as the following;

- Introduction to earth-moving equipment
- General information (operator's manuals, load capacity/weight, engine information)
- Safety aspects (safety decals, safety symbols, rules of the road, ppe)
- Automotive vs. equipment
- Pre-operation inspection (site inspection, equipment inspection, ROPS, gauges & controls, capacity)
- Operation of equipment (starting, traveling, loading, digging, shutdown)
- Maintenance & review
- Plus specific activities in which operators would encounter within their work place requirement regarding the operation of the skid-steer.

NOTE: The intent of this training course is to impart rules and practices of safe operation to all who use skid-steer type loaders. Practical evaluation of basic skid-steer maneuvers are performed but cannot be validated for operator's total performance and skill set. This student evaluation validates that the requested tasks were performed correctly and safely.

Training Materials: Those attending this training program will receive a training manual and Photo ID wallet card; that will be awarded to the student upon successful completion of the training course.
